

Trusted Digital Identity Bill 2021

I am lodging our objection to the Trusted Digital Identity Bill 2021 for the following reasons:

1. A centralised Digital Identity System allows future misuse by over-reaching or malevolent governments, governing bodies or bad actors that can access the system. The system may initially be created with safe-guards and assured privacy, but once the information is gathered, the protecting factors may change (due to political changes or pressures), at which point the gathered data and centralised control can be mis-used. Examples of misuse may include uses against individuals that are not in alignment with current governing bodies political views - irrespective of if the political views of the governing bodies are morally valid, or otherwise.

2. Centralising the Digital Identities of all individuals provides a central point of focus for hackers/organised crime syndicates/terrorists/extremists to focus their resources to either to gain access of or to control.

3. Absolute and indefinite assurance of impenetrable Cyber Security measures is impossible to provide, therefore whether a security breach will occur is a question of 'when', not a question of 'if'.

4. A centralised Digital Identity System contributes to the progression of the Globalist Movement, driven by the World Economic Forum as outlined in their paper "The Great Reset" by Mr. Klaus Schwab.

Although the proposed motion may appear a necessary move to certain elitist groups, the contents of the "Great Reset" paper make it clearly evident to the common individual that the system proposed mimics the technocratic authoritarian system of the Social Credit System currently in use within regions of China.

This system is incompatible with a democratic liberal society and a complete violation of people's privacy, rights and liberties. Any advancement of this agenda must be strongly opposed by all individuals wishing to maintain a free way of life.

5. Automated handling of data and information by the government has been demonstrated disastrous in past rollouts (for example Robodebt), causing emotional and financial distress to innocent civilians.
